
VIII. ADJOURNMENT

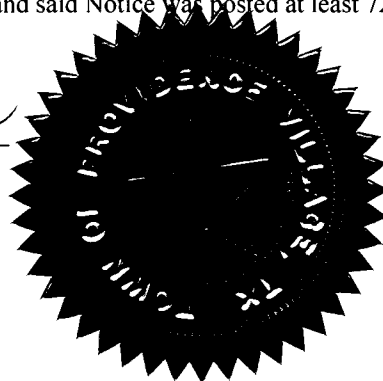
