What?


Come enjoy a beautiful staycation with the Denton County Master Gardener Association - Passport to Nature

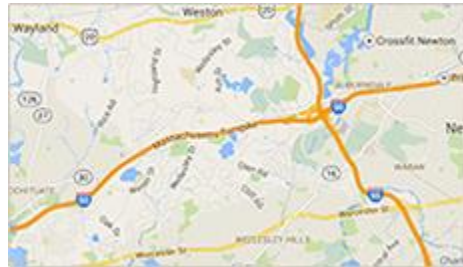
The event will be held rain or shine. Cameras are welcome.
