

RESOLUTION NO. 2011-10

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PROVIDENCE VILLAGE, DENTON COUNTY, TEXAS DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE SPECIAL ELECTION HELD ON TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 8, 2011, FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING TO THE QUALIFIED VOTERS OF THE TOWN OF PROVIDENCE VILLAGE, TEXAS, TWO BALLOT PROPOSITIONS FOR VOTER CONSIDERATION OF ADOPTING A REGULAR SALES AND USE TAX AT THE RATE OF ONE PERCENT AND ADOPTING A SALES TAX FOR PROPERTY TAX RELIEF OF ONE-HALF OF ONE PERCENT; PROVIDING FOR NOTICE OF SUCH ELECTION AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 321.405 of the Tax Code, the Town Council of the Town of Providence Village, Texas ("Town") must declare the results of the an election in which the voters approved the adoption of a sales tax authorized by the Code; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 321.405(b) of the Tax Code, the Town Secretary is required to send to the comptroller by certified mail, a certified copy of any resolution declaring the results of an election imposing sales tax, along with a map of the Town.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Providence Village, Texas:

SECTION 1: *Proposition No. 1*

A special election was held in and throughout the Town of Providence Village, Texas on Tuesday, November 8, 2011 at which election there was submitted to the resident registered voters of said Town, to vote "For" or "Against" the following propositions:

"A ONE PERCENT (1%) REGULAR SALES AND USE TAX IS ADOPTED WITHIN THE TOWN."

There was a total of 103 "For" votes casted and a total of 42 "Against" votes casted for Proposition No. 1. Proposition No. 1 was approved by a total of 61 votes.

SECTION 2: *Proposition No. 2*

A special election was held in and throughout the Town of Providence Village, Texas on Tuesday, November 8, 2011 at which election there was submitted to the resident registered voters of said Town, to vote "For" or "Against" the following propositions:

“A ONE-HALF OF ONE PERCENT (1/2%) SALES TAX FOR PROPERTY TAX RELIEF IS ADOPTED WITHIN THE TOWN.”

There was a total of 102 “For” votes casted and a total of 42 “Against” votes casted for Proposition No. 2. Proposition No. 2 was approved by a total of 60 votes.

SECTION 3: Severability


If any provision, section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this resolution, or the application of same to any person or set circumstances for any reason is held to be unconstitutional, void or invalid or for any reason unenforceable, the validity of the remaining portions of this resolution of the application thereby shall remain in effect, it being the intent of the Town Council of the Town of Providence Village, Texas in adopting this resolution, that no portion thereof or provision contained herein shall become inoperative or fail by any reason of unconstitutionality or invalidity of any portion or provision.

SECTION 4: Publishing and Effective Date

This resolution shall be published in accordance with the requirement of publishing all resolutions and/or ordinances and becomes effect in accordance with state law. Furthermore, the Town Secretary is hereby authorized to forward a certified copy of this resolution to the comptroller by U.S. certified mail, along with a copy of the Town map outlining the Town’s corporate limits.



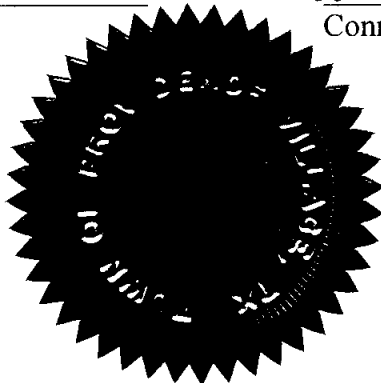
